My dear Mrs. Ranyard

My husband is writing this for me to let you know that I have this morning heard from Dr. Webb's wife; She tells me that she knows of excellent lodgings at 13 Hobson Place, at £2.2. or $\frac{1}{2}$ week - and she mentions two others besides - expressing however a susp. fear that if we do not close very soon, we shall lose the chance from the over-crowding of London by French refugees - My husband has also been rather disquieted by symptoms of inflammation (though slight, and we hope checked for the present) in ~~the~~^{my} other eye - and we have been urged by Dr. Evans (though he knew nothing of the latter circumst.)
